SUMMARY

"Chromebooks" run the "Chrome OS" as their operating system.

They started out with the "Chrome Web Store" which offers "Chrome Web apps" which is also part of the "Google Chrome" Web browser.

As of 2016, most "Chromebooks" also have the "Play Store".³

EXAMPLE OF A REALLY
CHEAP "CHROMEBOOK"

"Chrome Web Store"
offers
"Chrome Web apps",
"Chrome" extensions,
and
"Chrome" themes

"Play Store" offers
"Android apps", etc.

"Chrome Web apps"
and the
"Chrome Web Store"
will be phased out in
favor of "Progressive
Web Apps"

"Chrome OS" in
"Chromebooks" will
eventually have no
"Chrome Web Store".
Just the "Play Store" will
remain.

CONVERGENCE OF "WINDOWS.." AND "CHROMEOS"

- "ChromeOS" will eventually be able to run "Windows.." inside it:

QUEST TO INSTALL "CHROME OS" WITH BOTH THE "CHROME WEB STORE" AND THE GOOGLE "PLAY STORE" IN IT

- "FydeOS" is the only free Linux flavor that meets the above criteria
- "FydeOS" demands to know a valid phone number when you install it into a computer.

This is the only distro that does this.

- Without this phone number, you can only run "FydeOS" in "guest mode" and no "stores" are available.
