SUMMARY

The "Replay Media Catcher" program in the "Replay Capture Suite" has three capabilities:

- "Stream Downloader"
- "Digital Video Recorder"
- "Audio Recorder"

SUMMARY (continued)

For all three of these capabilities, the "Replay Media Catcher" is not fully compatible with the current Microsoft "Secure Boot" standard (while many of their free competitors are compatible).

(Microsoft mandated "Secure Boot" enabled in a "UEFI" for all Windows 8 and higher computers in August 2012.)

OVERVIEW OF "REPLAY MEDIA CATCHER"

- The "Stream Recorder" part of "Replay Media Catcher" is a full-featured, best-of-breed program that does a great job of "media capture" at the "network stack"
- The "Digital Video Recorder" of "Replay Media Catcher" is a limited "screen recorder" program that only records streaming videos that you are playing inside the proprietary "DVR browser" that is also part of "Replay Media Catcher"

OF "REPLAY MEDIA CATCHER" (= "SCREEN
RECORDER") (WORKS FOR WINDOWS 7, 8.1
AND VERSION 1803 OF WINDOWS 10..)**

OVERVIEW.. (continued)

- The "Stream Downloader" inside "Replay Media Catcher" does a better and faster job of "media capture" at the network stack than any other free or not-free software program that we have tested.

The "Stream Downloader" of "Replay Media Catcher" has successfully done "media capture" inside every computer that we have installed "Replay Media Catcher" into⁷.

OVERVIEW.. (continued)

- The "Digital Video Recorder" inside "Replay Media Catcher" has a very limited ability to do "screen recording". Since the "Digital Video Recorder" only records from the "DVR Browser" which is a proprietary web browser that is part of "Replay Media Catcher" so you cannot do a screen recording of the "Windows.." desktop or any other program or window.

OVERVIEW.. (continued)

- The "Digital Video Recorder" of "Replay Media Catcher" has failed to perform "screen recording" inside 60 percent of the "Windows 10.." computers that we installed "Replay Media Catcher" into.

For all of the "Windows 10" computers where the "Digital Video Recorder" failed, the "Stream Downloader" worked okay in spite of the failure of "Digital Video Recorder".

OVERVIEW.. (continued)

- If "Digital Video Recorder" of "Replay Media Catcher" fails to perform "screen recording" inside a "Windows.." computer for you, you can install and the not-free "Replay Video Capture" or the free "aTube Catcher" instead.

"REPLAY MEDIA CATCHER" IS NOT FULLY COMPATIBLE WITH MICROSOFT'S "SECURE BOOT" STANDARD YET

- When you install and then start up "Replay Media Catcher" in any "Windows 10" computer, you get the following ominous warning:

Enter (or Drag and Drop) the URL of a video page to download



This computer has an UEFI BIOS with SecureBoot enabled.

Replay Media Catcher 7 has multiple audio recording methods.

The "Applications" audio recording method is preferred to prevent system sounds from mixing with a recording. This recording method MAY require that SecureBoot be disabled to function.

If you find that the "Applications" audio recording method does not function then please refer to the online guide for this product for instructions on how to disable SecureBoot in the BIOS.

Alternatively, you may use the Stereo Mix (What you hear) audio recording method which does not require any changes to SecureBoot.

The audio recording method to use can be changed in the application's Settings screen.

- "Jacksta Technologies" in Western Australia is the software developer of "Replay Media Catcher". They have had the past 7 years to make "Replay Media Catcher" compatible with "Secure Boot" but apparently have failed to accomplish this.
