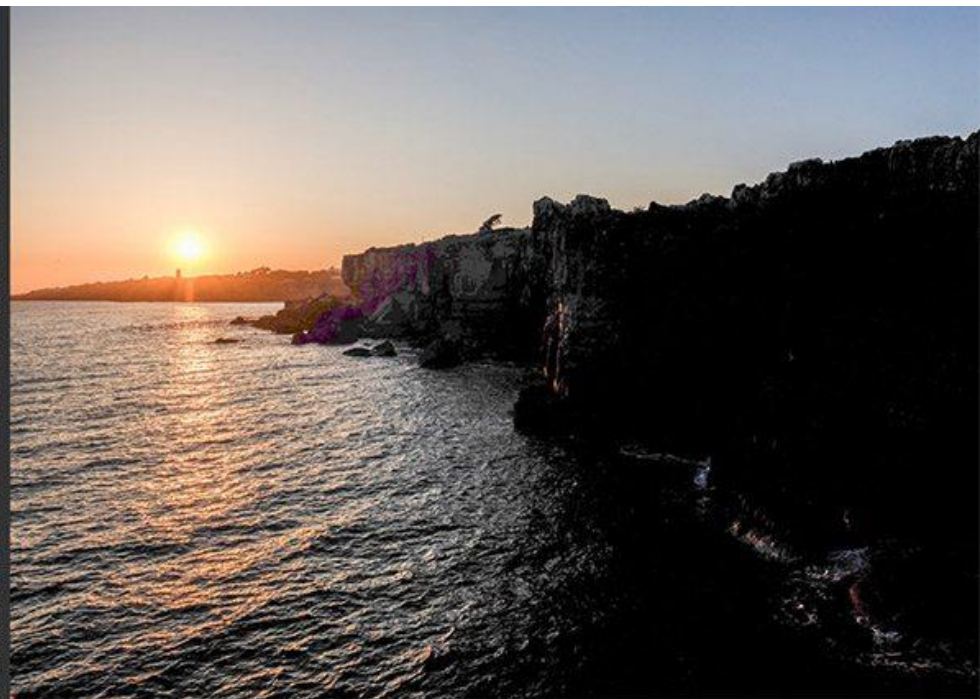
Can import .JPG files into a photo project	?

Can adjust the brightness of a photo project	?
Can adjust the input-output brightness "x-y" curve of a photo project	?
Can adjust the contrast of a photo project	?
Can perform a rectangular crop on a photo project	?
