SUMMARY

In "Windows 8..", "Windows Explorer" is now called "File Explorer".

However, (similar to "Windows Explorer" in "Windows Vista" and "Windows 7", it still starts up in "Libraries" view instead of "Computer" view. Here are the steps for making "File Explorer" in "File Explorer" of "Windows 8" start up in "Computer" view.

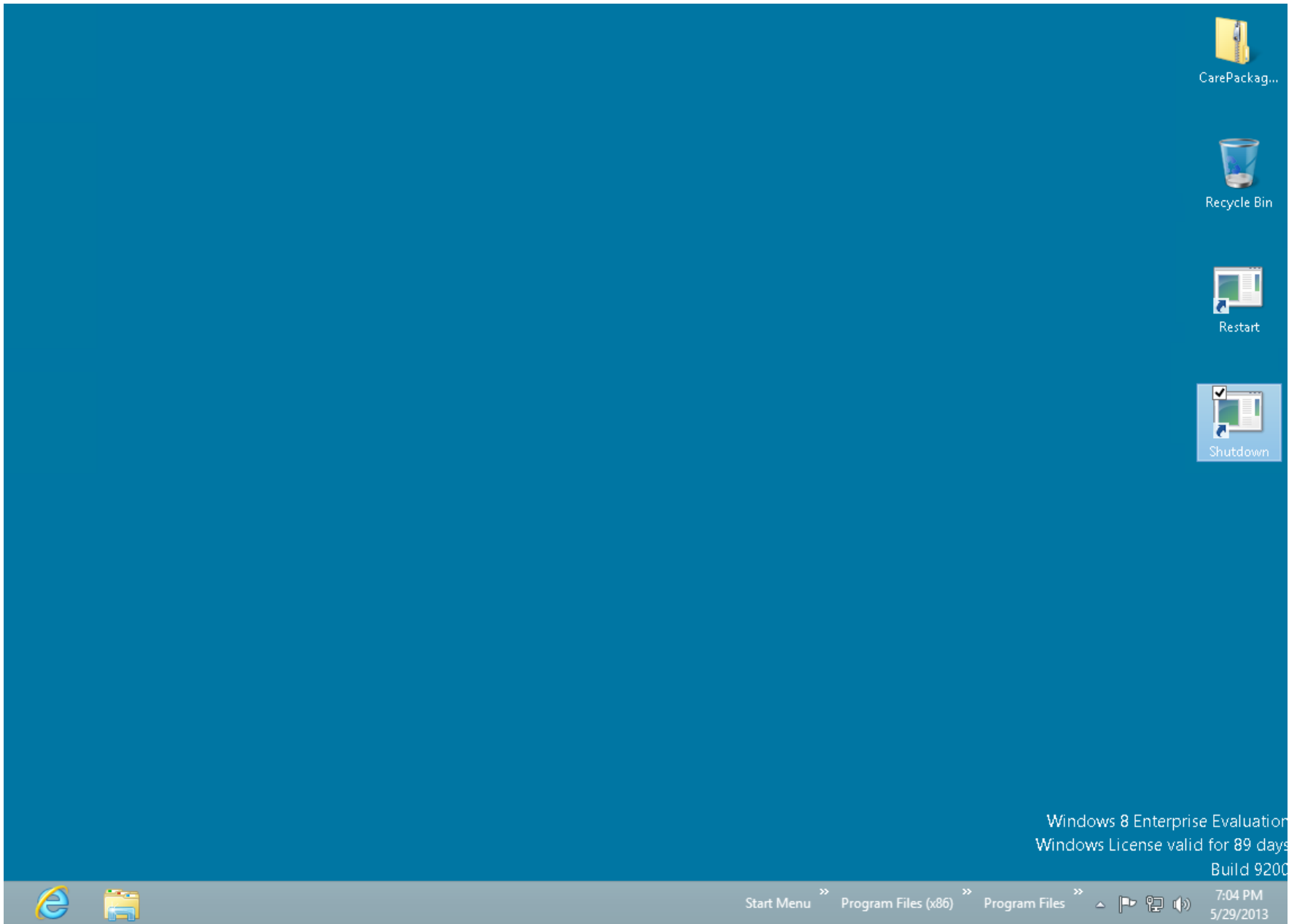

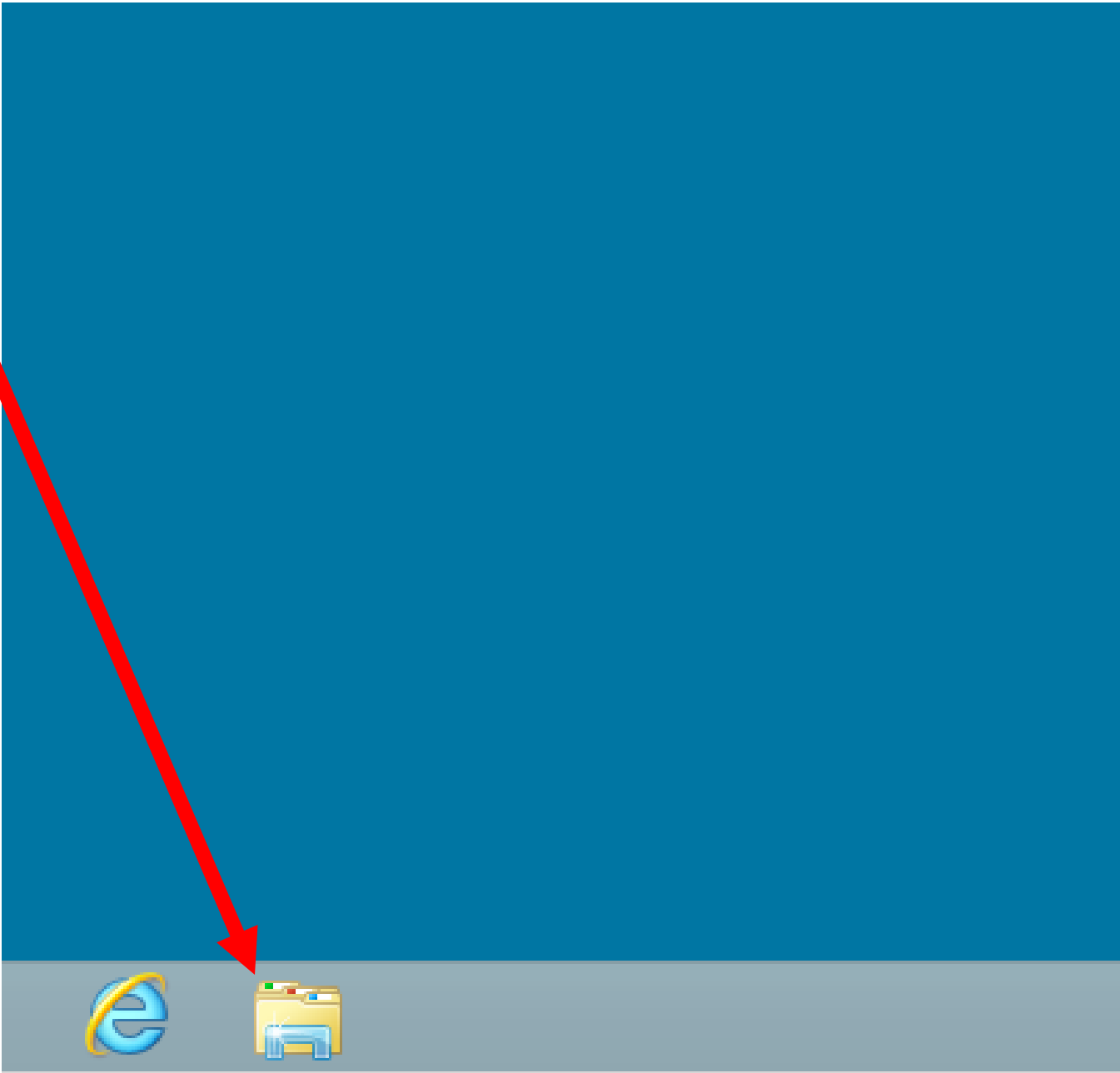
Make "File Explorer" in "Windows 8" Start
Up in "Computer" View (continued)

Step 1: Go to the "Desktop" of
"Windows 8", if you are not already
in it. (If you are in a "Windows
Store App" or the Windows 8
"Start" screen, press the "Windows
key and leave it down + press the
d key and hold it down. Then
release both keys.)

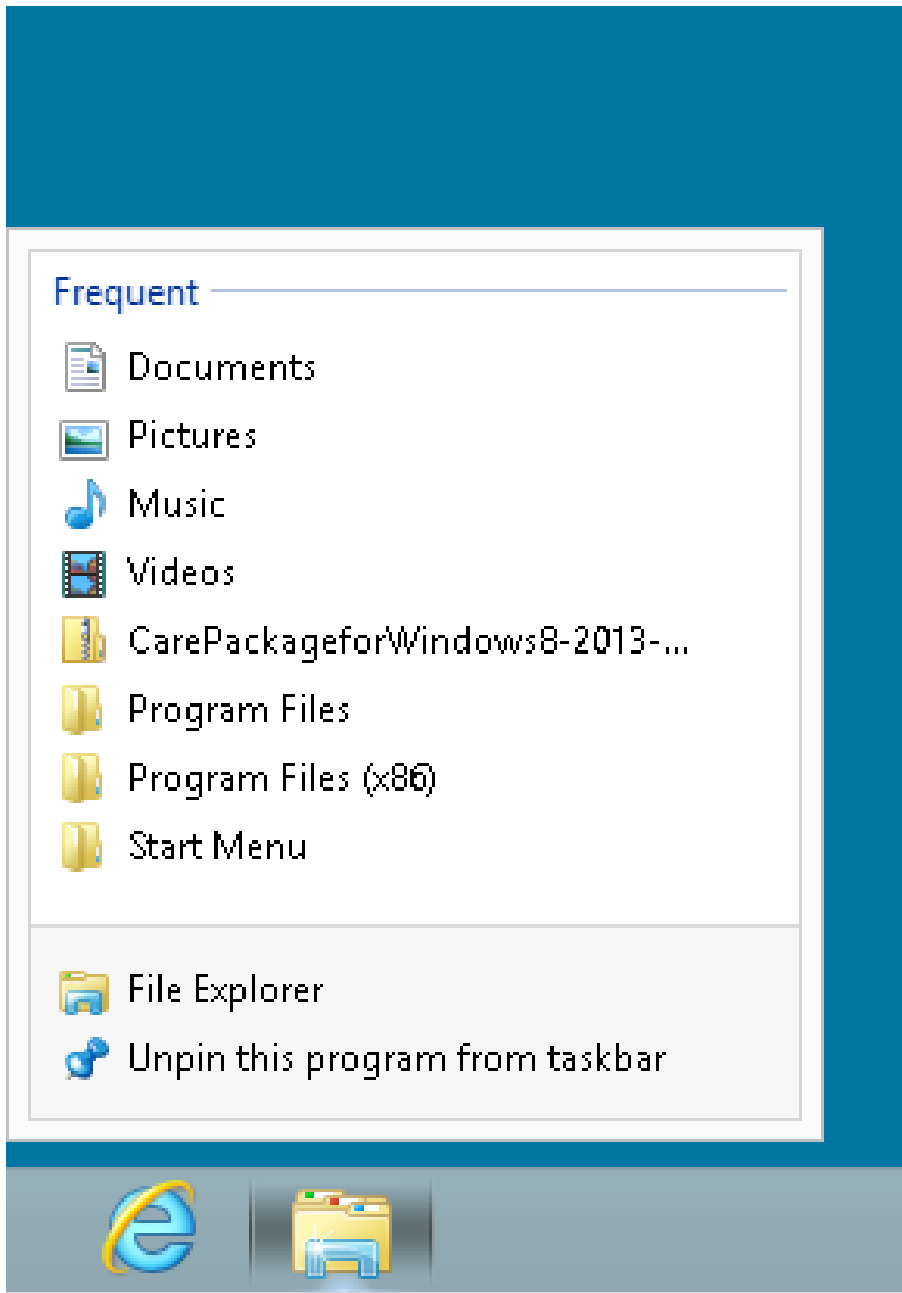
Step 2: Locate any icon for "File
Explorer". (You probably have one
on the gray Task Bar.):

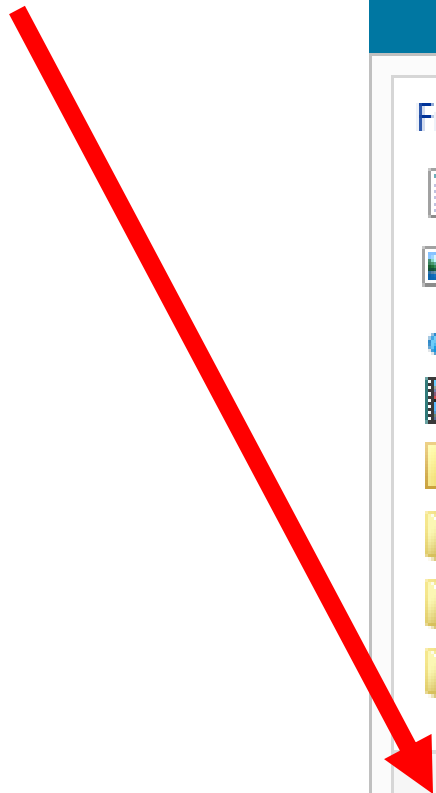
Step 3: Use the RIGHT mouse
button to click on the "File
Explorer" icon.

Step 4: A pop-up context menu will
be displayed:

button to click on the "File
Explorer" in the pop-up context
menu:**



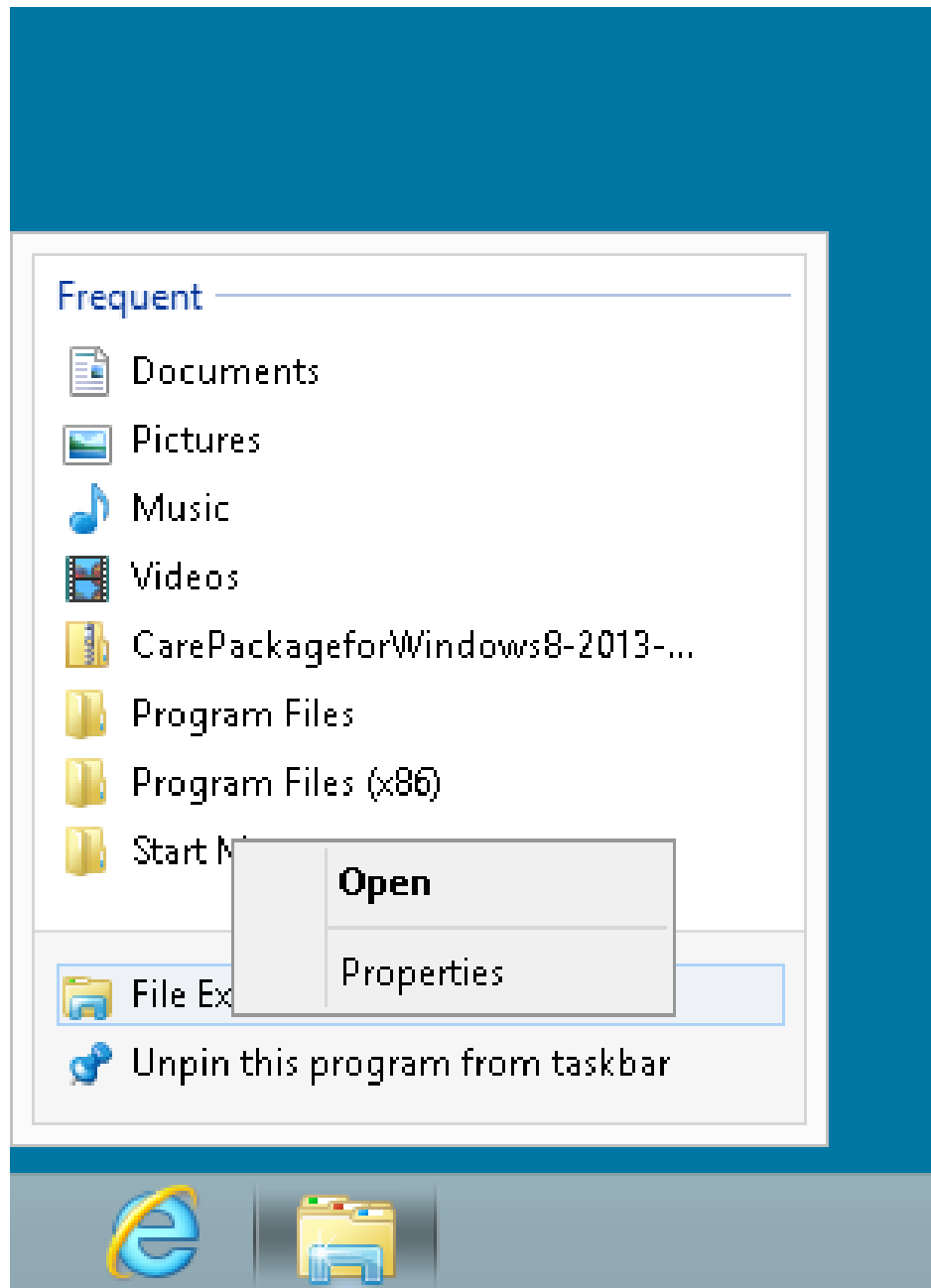

**Step 9: Delete all of the text in the
text box to the right of "Target:":**



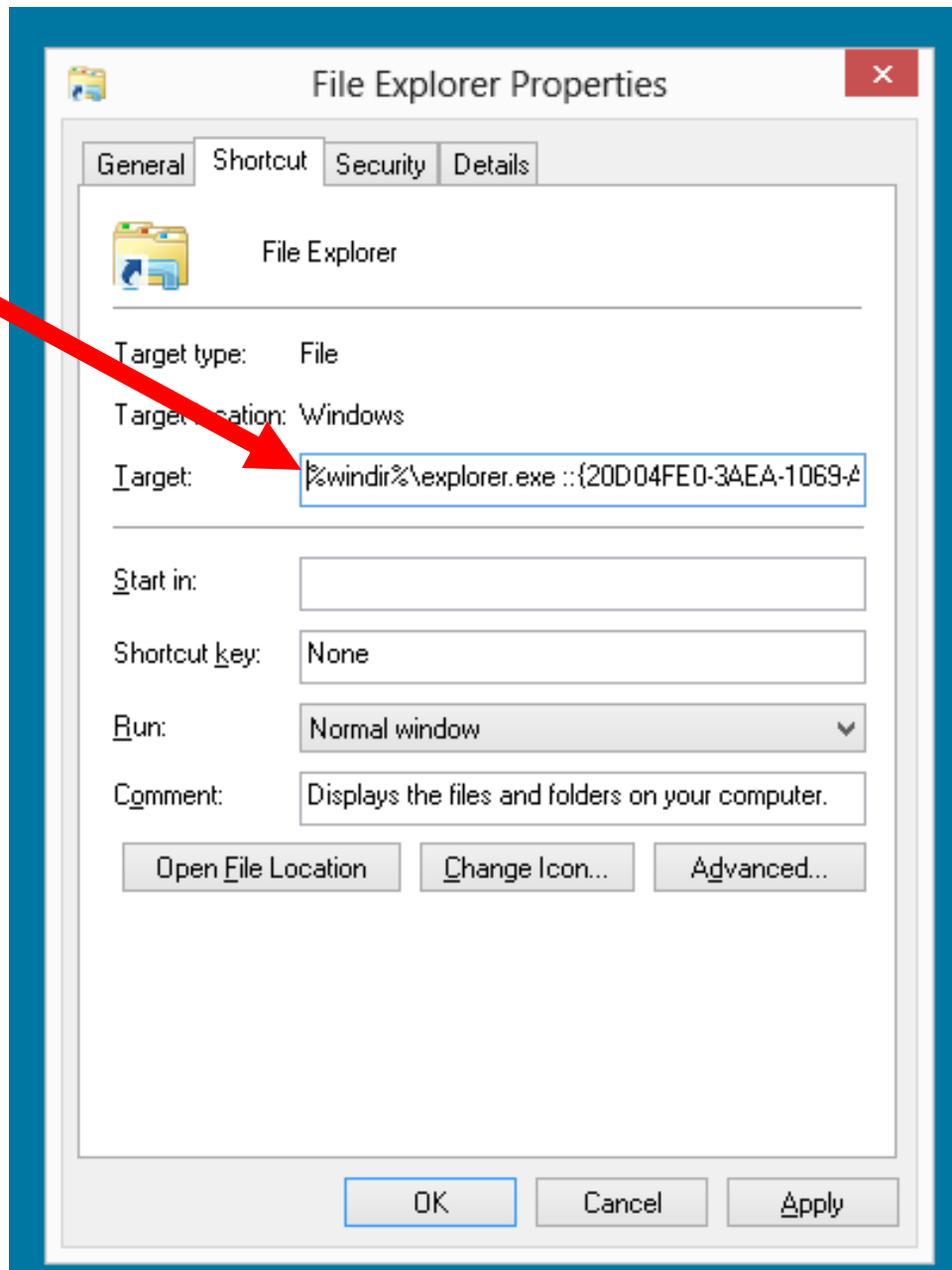
Make "File Explorer" in "Windows 8" Start Up in "Computer" View (continued)

Step 10: Copy or type the following
text into the text box to the right of
"Target:":

```
%windir%\explorer.exe
```

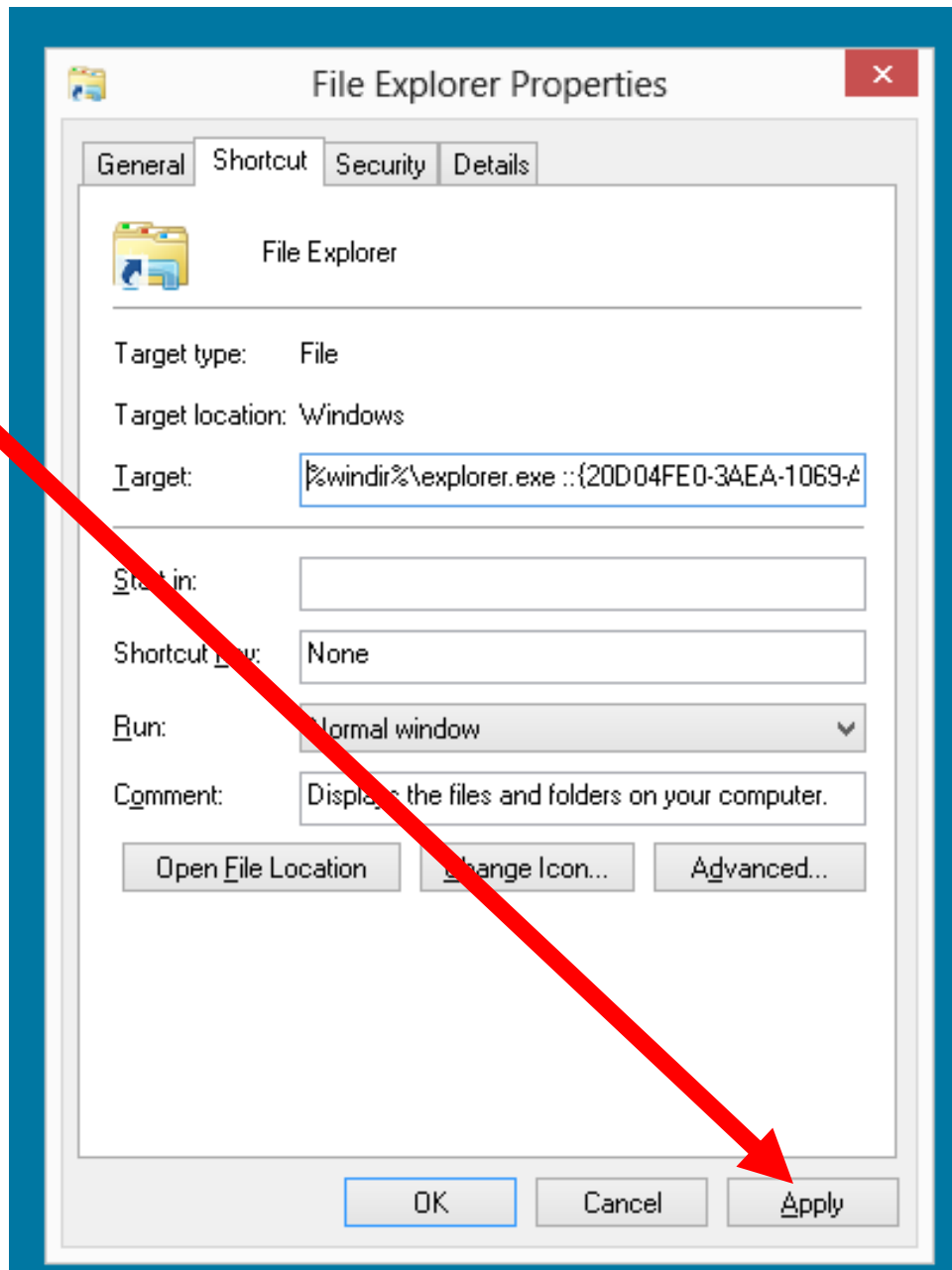
```

(There is one space between .exe
and ::)



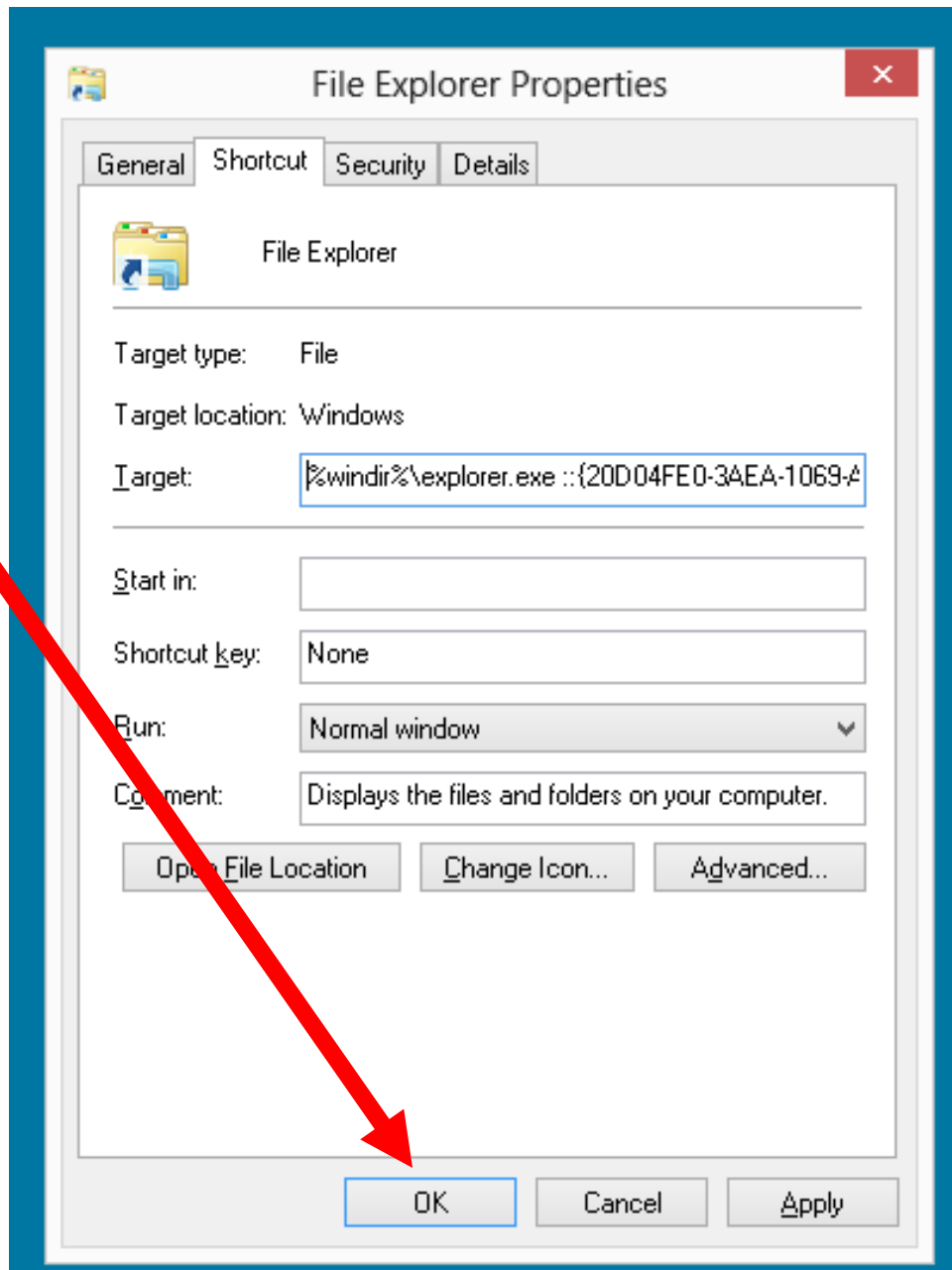
Make "File Explorer" in "Windows 8" Start

**Step 11: Click on the "Apply"
button.**



Make "File Explorer" in "Windows 8" Start
Up in "Computer" View (continued)

Step 10: Click on the "OK" button
and the "File Explorer Properties"
box will disappear.

Step 11: From now on, when you
start "File Explorer", the
"Computer" view will be displayed:
