

"Spot On" Virtual Smartfence

This system can create one or more "virtual fences" for your dog. They can be any shape or size (within reason) and does not require any wires.

So how does the device do this?

It uses global satellite systems and cell towers to create its virtual fences. All you do is walk the path you want for the fence to create while holding the collar in your hand. Sixty days of cell service is included; then it is \$6.95 per month thereafter.



You can create up to ten areas without the need for underground wires or base station. Your cell phone gives you all the info you need and want. Your dog gets an alert warning as he approaches the fence and a warning tone if he goes closer.

Your dog's location is shown on the cell phone's map screen if you cannot see him. If he manages to escape the fence, your cell phone instantly shows exactly where he is with no delay. Your cell phone gives you driving directions to get to where he is right now. Or you can use compass mode to see which way to walk to find him.

To set up a fence, you use the collar itself to do so, walking the perimeter as you go. The collar will remember the route you walked and save it. You need to train your dog on how to use the system. There is video material that shows you how to do it.

What's nice about this system is that you can use it when you are on vacation to establish an area for your dog to roam. You can also take the system with you if you move.

While there a lot of really nice features about this system, the price is quite high.
